Project title	Town twinning between Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg - St. Petersburg/Russia
Short description of the project	The participation in this project is using know-how and to coach the management of the City of St. Petersburg. Introduction of a mobile collection system for dangerous waste from households. The project started in 2006. It is orientated by the collecting system in Hamburg. In the first step in 2008 mercury lamps were collected as a pilot project. The collection system was 2009 widened by the additional collection of batteries and accumulators. The collection system was introduced 2010 in the City by using a collection vehicle (Ecomobil). In 2011 the PR was added by printing a brochure and posters to inform the citizens.
